Dear Dr. Garcia:

The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, at its meeting January 14-15, 2026, reviewed the Follow-Up Report and related evidentiary materials submitted by Mt. San Antonio College. The Commission also considered the Peer Review Team Follow-Up Report prepared by the follow-up team that visited the institution on October 23, 2025. The purpose of this review was to determine whether the College has addressed the deficiencies identified by the peer review team during the June 2024 comprehensive visit and demonstrated compliance with the Standards cited in the Commission's June 12, 2024, Action Letter.

Upon consideration of the information noted above, the Commission acted to **Reaffirm Accreditation** for the remainder of the cycle. The Commission finds that Mt. San Antonio College has addressed the compliance requirements, corrected deficiencies, and meets **Standard II.A.7 and Policy on Distance Education and on Correspondence Education**.

The Commission requires that you disseminate the Follow-Up Report, the Peer Review Team Report, and this letter to all campus constituencies and the public by placing copies on the College website within seven business days of your receipt. A final copy of the Peer Review Team Report is attached.

The next report from the College will be the Midterm Report¹ due on March 15, 2028. The institution's next comprehensive review will begin with Team ISER Review in the fall term of 2030 and conclude with a Focused Site Visit in the spring term of 2031.
