

Mt. SAC SCE is the third largest 3 noncredit program in the California Community Colleges.

SCE was established in 1971. SCE Programs serve students 1971 across the lifespan including adult learners, minors, and senior citizens.

SCE generated 7,680 Full-Time Equivalent Students (FTES) in 2017-18.

SCE holds dual accreditation by the Western Association of Schools and College (ACS and ACCJC).

Noncredit courses are offered four terms per year with 4 weekend and evening options available.

Classes are available on campus and at over 50 communitybased sites.




