DEISA Committees Comparison Chart</p>	<p>11:30am</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The purpose of the document was to analyze all three DEISA committees to identify where our work overlaps. • All three committees were reviewed to identify where our work overlaps and how this committee could leverage that. • PAC had two recommendations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ #1 was a name change since – proposed to change to a committee instead of council. ○ #2 to have 3 committees report to the DEISA • Campus Equity Diversity Committee(CEDC) which is currently under HR and Student Preparation Equity and Achievement Council (SPEAC) are proposed to be under DEISA. This is currently under review because our work is now framed differently. • Committee reviewed the new language for the Purpose and Function Statement. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Functions 3 and 4 were combined. • Motion made by Kelly F. to accept the documents as edited. Motion was seconded by Lisa R. All were in favor to approve. There were no nays and no abstentions. • Lisa R. stated that at some point, fiscal services looks at DEISA driven decision on budgets – how do we decide on funds – Reports on the budgeting. Asking for DEISA reports from HR.
