5.	CEDC Committee Composition	 E. Santiago projected the current list of committee members and explained the pending responses. E. Kaljumagi shared that he will not continue with the committee after participating for six years. L. Rodriguez shared that she serves on the DEISA+ Council and suggested a report out from CEDC regarding EEO Plan/Report. Both committees have attempted to meet; pending rescheduling. L. Bass shared that some of the appointing groups with vacant memberships have remained vacant, so she suggested reducing the number of representatives in certain groups. S. Bacigalupi agreed. 	

6. Roundtable	 L. Bass shared that CCCCO does not collect Middle Eastern/North African data, which is the disconnect in the College's underrepresented groups. E. Kaljumagi feels umbrella categories are inadequate for data (Asian versus subcategories Korean, Chinese, etc.). Believes the committee should study why this data matters. L. Bass responded that employees have the option to share their subcategories and projected the list for the committee to see. R. Cash thanked the committee for their contribution.
