	Prescreening of Outdated (pre-2007) Equivalent Art Computer Information Systems Family and Consumer Sciences Communication Agriculture Physics	The committee reviewed existing equivalencies for Art, CIS, FCS, Communication, Agriculture, and Physics. General comments wer Equivalencies for vocational disciplines (those not requiring master's degree) must have at least two years of work experience and the minimum of eighteen semester units of General Education specified in Title 5 Section 55063. A master's degree by itself does not meet the two years of wo experience requirement. Equivalencies must state whether they are intended to supersede the state's stated minimum qualification or wheth they are intended to provide an additional means of qualifyi for employment at Mt. SAC. The form will be updated to reflect this. An equivalency can only be made to an official state discipling and each course must be assigned to at least one discipline.
