

## Chapter 4 – Academic Affairs

### BP 4240 Academic Renewal Without Course Repetition

#### References:

Title 5, Section 55044, Board Policy 3255

The College President/CEO, in consultation with the Academic Senate, shall establish procedures that provide for academic renewal without course repetition. This policy is provided for students in specific circumstances where previously recorded substandard academic performance is not reflective of the student's present demonstrated ability. Academic renewal without course repetition applies only to substandard coursework completed at Mt. SAC. For purposes of this policy, a substandard grade is defined as a **D, DV, F, FV, NC, NP, and NPV.**

This policy will permit previously recorded substandard coursework to be **disregarded renewed** in the computation of a student's grade point average. In doing so, the permanent academic record shall be annotated in such a manner that all work remains legible, ensuring a true and complete academic history.

Students with substandard coursework completed at other colleges/universities need to contact those institutions to see if they are eligible for academic renewal under the provisions of academic renewal of **said that** institution.
