### AP 4010 Academic Calendar

Education Code Section 79020; Title 5 Sections 55700 et seq. and 58142

The academic year consists of 175 days of instruction. Flexible days, **also known as “Flex Days,”** are considered part of the 175 days of instruction.

The College and offices of the College shall be closed on the following holidays:

- New Year’s Day (January 1)
- Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (Third Monday in January)
- Lincoln Day (February 12 *or see Note below*)
- Washington Day (Third Monday in February)
- Cesar Chavez Day (March 30)
- Memorial Day (Last Monday in May)
- Juneteenth (June 19 *or another day in lieu as bargained*)
- Independence Day (July 4)
- Labor Day (First Monday in September)
- Veterans Day (November 11 *or see Note below*)
- Thanksgiving Day (Fourth Thursday in November)
- Day after Thanksgiving Day (Fourth Friday in November)
- Christmas Eve Day (December 24)
- Christmas Day (December 25)
- New Year’s Eve Day (December 31)

Other Holidays: The Board of Trustees may declare other days to be holidays and close the College and offices when good reason exists.

Note: Education Code 79020 addresses the scheduling of Lincoln Day, Veterans Day, and holidays that fall on weekends.

**Annually, the College President/CEO (or designee), shall meet with Faculty Association, CSEA 262, and CSEA 651 to agree on a proposed academic calendar. The proposed academic calendar must be approved by the Board of Trustees annually.**
