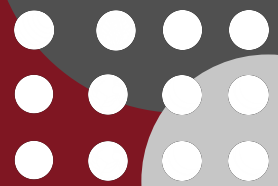


CCC to HBCU Transfer Guarantee

This resource is designed to help Mt. SAC students explore the opportunities available through the **CCC to HBCU Transfer Guarantee** and prepare for a successful transfer to a participating HBCU.

What Is It?

The CCC to HBCU Transfer Guarantee provides California Community College students with a pathway to **guaranteed admission to more than 30 Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs)**. This program helps students continue their undergraduate degree journey at an HBCU while providing resources and guidance to support a successful transfer.

Who Is Eligible?

Any California community college student with a GPA of 2.0 or higher (certain partner HBCUs may require a higher GPA) is guaranteed admission to all partner HBCU institutions using either of the following two options while at a California Community College:

1. Complete an **Associate Degree for Transfer** (AD-T) or
2. Complete a minimum of **30 UC or CSU units**

Students completing an Associate degree (non-ADT) are welcomed to apply to all partner institutions, however; the benefit of guaranteed admissions is not offered and all degree applicable units are subject to transcript evaluation.

Explore Participating HBCUs

Review the list of participating HBCUs that offer guaranteed admission through the CCC to HBCU Transfer Guarantee program. Explore each institution to learn about its academic programs, campus culture, and transfer requirements to find the best fit for your educational goals.

If your preferred HBCU is not a participating institution, you may still apply directly to that college or university as a general transfer student.

Meet With A Counselor

Schedule an appointment with a counselor to discuss your interest in the CCC to HBCU Transfer Guarantee Program and develop a MAP (education plan) that supports your academic and transfer goals.
