

Am I Eligible for ACADEMIC RENEWAL?

Academic Renewal without course repetition is a process which factors out substandard grades (any course in which a grade of D, F, or NP was recorded) from the official Mt. SAC transcript of record.

What are the eligibility requirements?

Since the last term to be disregarded, you must have earned one of the following:

- 3.0 GPA with 18 semester units or
- 2.5 GPA with 24 semester units or
- 2.0 GPA with 30 semester units

How many units may be disregarded?

- Up to 30 units

I have attended other colleges, do I need to submit official transcripts?

Only if the courses completed will support the units/GPA policy to meet eligibility requirements
