

Library Use Agreement

The purpose of the Mt. San Antonio College Library is to "support student learning by providing access to information competency instruction, comprehensive collections, current educational

technology, and diverse learning spaces" (BP 4040). To achieve this, the Library aims to have a welcoming, inclusive, and inspiring space for learning. When using library services, users must adhere to the Mt. SAC Standards of Conduct (BP 5500). When using Library technology, users must follow Mt. SAC's User of Technology and Information Resources and Employee Acceptable Use Agreement (AP 3720).

Library users are responsible for contributing to this atmosphere and respecting the needs of other users. Unacceptable behavior includes but is not limited to the following:

Engaging in harassing or discriminatory behavior based on perceived or actual disability, gender, gender identify, gender expression, marital status, nationality, race or ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, or any other status protected by law.

Engaging in intimidating conduct or harassment to Library users or Library employees through words or actions.

Disruptive behavior, willful disobedience, habitual profanity or vulgarity, or the open and persistent defiance of the authority of, or persistent abuse of, Library employees.

Lewd, indecent, or obscene conduct on College-owned or college online venues.

Occasionally, Library employees may need to remind Library users of this agreement. We ask that Library users work with us to maintain an atmosphere of mutual respect by following this agreement. Please note, non-compliance with this agreement can result in Library users being asked to leave by Library employees or Police and Campus Safety. Repeated violations of this agreement can result in the removal of Library privileges. Thank you for your cooperation.
