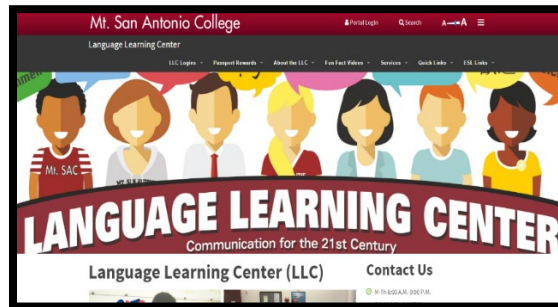
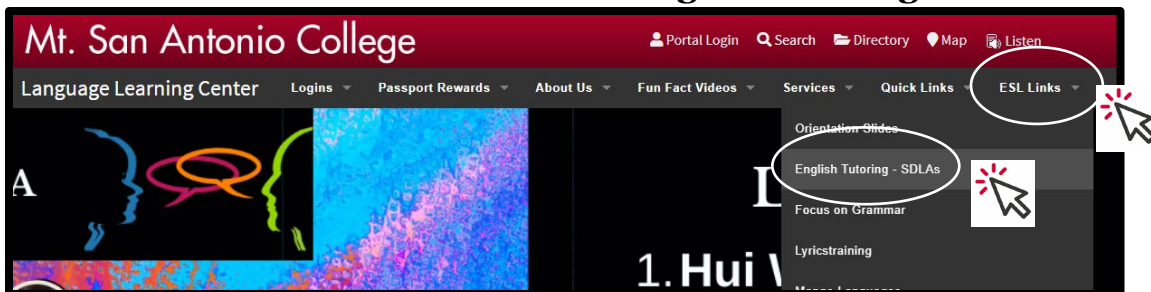


How to Use the ESL Tutoring Website

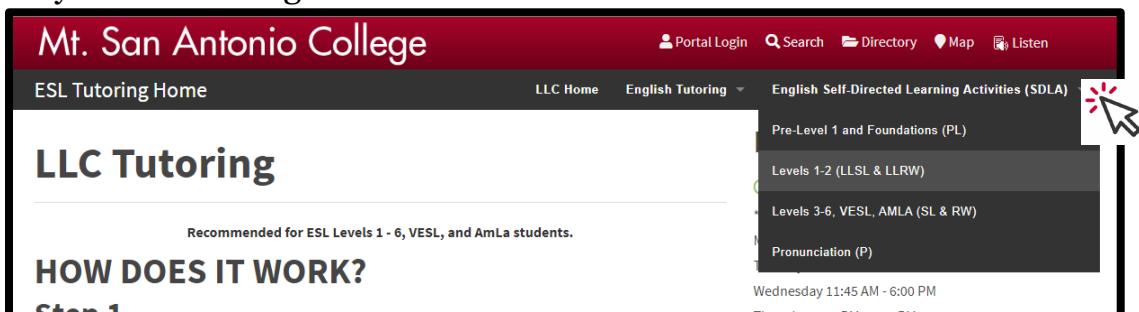
Step 1: Go to mtsac.edu/llc



Step 2: Click  “ESL Links” and click  on “English tutoring – SDLAs”



Step 3: Click  “English Self-Directed Learning Activities (SDLA)” and choose the type of SDLA you are working on.
