

## President's Cabinet Action Notes June 25, 2024

- 1. Cabinet reviewed and commented on the following standing items:
  - a. Marketing and Public Affairs provided the following updates to Cabinet:
    - Last week, Jill provided four Mt. SAC presentations to the community. An additional
      presentation is scheduled for tomorrow, and a few more are scheduled to be
      presented in early July. All presentations have been well-received by the community
      groups.
    - Jill will be writing a Newsroom story highlighting two biology students that discovered an endangered bumble bee in the Wildlife Sanctuary.
    - Community Mailer #2 will be mailed to our District service area community members and is expected to be delivered the week of July 6<sup>th</sup>. Digital ads have been completed and sent to the consultant for dissemination.
    - The new mascot name is Rizzly the Grizzly.
  - b. Cabinet received the following diversity, equity, inclusion, social justice, anti-racism, and accessibility updates:
    - Romelia Salinas received the Lifetime Achievement Award from REFORMA. She is recognized for her mentorship to the next generation of librarians, particularly those from Latino backgrounds. Congratulations to Romelia!
    - SCE hosted an Older Adult Open House in Pomona.
  - c. Cabinet received the following enrollment updates:
    - SCE will provide updated enrollment data on July 8th.
    - Credit enrollment for Summer 2024 increased 16% in comparison to Summer 2023.
      Fall credit enrollment is lower in comparison to the same day of registration last year;
      however, this is due to the change in registration dates. Students are registering
      earlier for classes now. Registration for the Fall semester will continue during the
      Summer.
