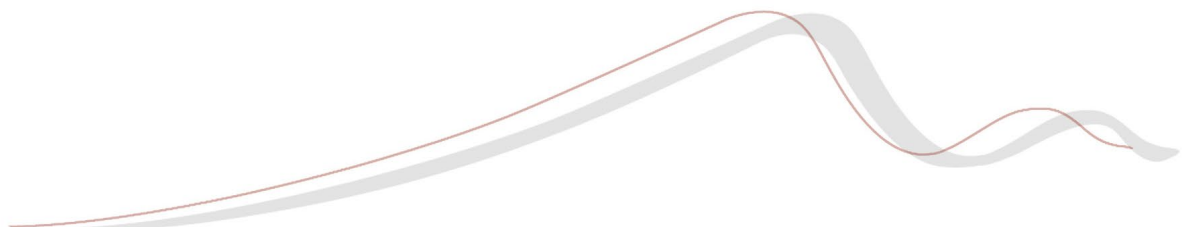


President's Cabinet Action Notes **October 14, 2025**

3. California Volunteers has announced their 2026 [#CaliforniansForAll College](#) Corps Funding Opportunity application. The application is due on Monday, November 24, 2025. The initiative is open to higher education institutions that operate within California, and has three primary goals:
 - 1) Engage college students in meaningful service opportunities that build leadership skills and civic responsibility.
 - 2) Help students from diverse backgrounds graduate college on time and with less debt; and
 - 3) Support the work of community-based organizations focused on key local priorities (e.g., K-12 education, food insecurity, climate action).

Student Services will review the requirements to complete the application. It is essential to provide students with as many opportunities as possible.
