STEPS TO BECOME A WORK STUDY STUDENT

1

Make sure your FAFSA is on file

2

Get awarded through Financial Aid

If you are awarded, you will need to accept the offer through your [portal](#) like any other grant. If you are not awarded, contact Mt. SAC [Financial Aid](#) to see why.

3

Complete Work Study Orientation

Review and complete the [FWS Student Orientation and Acknowledgment Form](#)

4

Search for a job with the Career Center

Create your [Handshake account](#) through the Mt. SAC Career Center. This is where you will search for and apply to all on campus jobs. The Career Center can also help you with your resume if you need to update one.

5

Apply for a job

When you find a job you would like to apply for, follow all instructions on the posting. Make sure you complete and submit the [FWS Employment Application](#) for each posting.

6

Interview and get hired

Check your email for an invitation to an interview from the employer. If you are selected there will be a hiring and document signing process you will go through with the [Career Center](#).
