How the program works:

- Classes are designed to **get you ready to take a GED subject test in 16 weeks**. it might feel overwhelming if you start later in a session. That's ok! Everything will be easier when the class restarts in the Winter.
- You do not need to attend every day, but **the more you attend, the faster you will finish!**
