Production courses and realized he wanted to
pursue the credit pathway for the Music
Technology and Recoding Arts A.S. degree. He
jumped right in with credit through CPL!

### Mirrored Noncredit

### Student Example

Martha entered the Community Health Worker pathway through the introductory noncredit courses. After connecting with a job placement, she moved to the credit pathway allowing her to continue credit coursework for the Community Health Worker Certificate of Achievement without retaking courses.

Julio graduated immediately upon completion of his final GE coursework.





### Rocio Garcia

Thanks to CPL, Rocio is now a full-time tenure-track professor at West Los Angeles College.

Starting in adult school, Rocio later received 16 units of credit for her California Registered Dental Assistant certification. This enabled her to complete a Bachelor's in Science in Dental Hygiene (BSDH) a semester early and saved her the all the costs associated with full-time studies. It also allowed her to meet minimum qualifications for her current position and start earning earlier than she would have otherwise.

And the kicker: Rocio completed her Master's Degree in Education in spring 2025! Adult School to Masters—Ms. Garcia's opportunities are now endless.





#### FIR101 - Fire Protection Organization

### Mock Up

#### **Course Description**

This course provides an introduction to fire protection. Topics covered include career opportunities in fire protection and related fields, fire loss analysis, organization and function of public and private fire protection services, and laws and regulations affecting the fire service. Students will be introduced to fire service nomenclature, basic fire chemistry and physics, fire protection systems, and fire strategy and tactics. (Formerly FIR 151: Introduction to Fire Technology) NOTE: Students taking online courses must log in during the first week of the course or make special arrangements with the instructor to avoid being dropped.:

#### **Credit for Prior Learing Eligibility**

Firefighter 1 Certificate of Completion, plus a Verification Experience Letter from the Fire Chief or authorized designee (signature on file with State Fire Training) identifying 6 months full-time or 12 months part-time experience.

### **EMS** Corps



5-month intensive EMT Licensing program for youth (18-24) who experience significant barriers. It provides stipends, counseling and mentoring, and job placement and has an 85% success rate.

Until this year, EMS training was offered through ROP, adult education, and private training agencies and students had no pathway to college.

The program has now expanded to 10 CCC credit sites through Instructional Service Agreements (ISAs) and has scaled nationally to 16 sites total.
