



High School Outreach Fall 2020 In-District High School Report

Graduating High School seniors are afforded the opportunity to participate in activities at their school through High School Outreach (HSO). Presentations are intended to facilitate: student's understanding of the benefits of a college education, enrollment procedures, and transition to college. Seniors who are considering attending Mt. SAC and attend HSO activities at the high school are offered the opportunity to participate in the Connect 4 Program. Connect 4 students receive guided assistance through the enrollment process, connections to special support programs, and receive early registration for the first incoming fall semester. The chart below shows the types and number of times the presentations were given as well as the number of students served at these presentations.

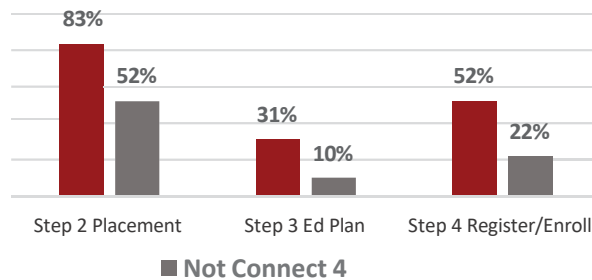
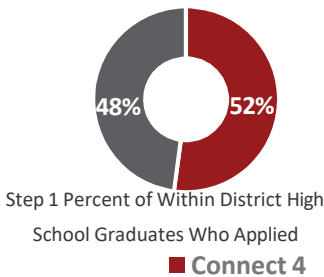
Step 1 Apply for the Fall semester

Fall 2020 Overall Connect 4 Outcomes by Step



6,644 graduating students from high schools within the Mt. SAC district applied to be a student at Mt. SAC. Of the 3,460 students who did so through the Connect 4 program 83% completed the English and math assessment questionnaire AQ. 1,050 Connect 4 students created an ed plan and 1,787 enrolled in classes Fall 2020.

Overall Fall 2020 Enrollment Type

58% of the Connect 4 students enrolled in 12 or more units during the Fall 2020 term. This is considered full-time. 40% of the Not Connect 4 students enrolled in 12 or more units.
