
Interview Prep Workshops: The <u>Career Center</u> offers dedicated workshops focused on interview preparation and networking. These sessions often include mock interviews where students can practice their skills in a simulated environment, receive constructive feedback from peers or career specialists, and refine their interviewing techniques

Career Specialist - Division of Technology and Health: Contact your <u>Technology and</u>
<u>Health Career Specialist</u> for assistance with coordinating a simulated (mock) interview with someone in your career field.

Yoodli - An <u>AI powered tool</u> trusted by companies such as Google. The platform analyzes your speech patterns, identifies filler words, and provides suggestions for improvement. Has a free plan that allows you to practice full conversations as they would occur in real interviews.
