# There are many forms of aid available:

# **Fee Waiver**

California Community College Promise Grant (Formally known as the BOG Fee Waiver) - waives your enrollment fees.

# **Grants** – As long as you complete your classes they do not need to be paid back!

Pell Grant = Money from the Federal Government

Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG) = Money from the Federal Government

**Cal Grant** = Money from the California Government

Chaffey Grant = Money for former foster youth\*

\*To apply you must submit a financial aid application and an additional application

# **Additional Forms of Aid**

#### **Work Study:**

 Work Study= Money earned by working in specific work study funded jobs

(Jobs are not guaranteed, students must apply and be selected)

#### Loans:

- Mt SAC Emergency Loans= Short-term loans to buy books. MUST PAY BACK within 30 days to avoid paying interest.
- Direct Loans = <u>MUST PAY BACK</u>, better to use after transfer

#### **Scholarships:**

Scholarships = Free money from organizations or donors
(You need to apply for scholarships separately from the other kinds of financial aid listed here)

# **How to Apply** – Application opens Oct 1<sup>st</sup>. To get the max award possible apply by the March 2<sup>nd</sup> priority deadline.

To be eligible for AB540 a student must have a high school diploma or the equivalent from California, and have attended a California High School, Middle School or Elementary School for a combined 3 years or more.
